## CHURCH HISTORY

Epikos was started by Danny Parmelee in 2005 as a focus on college-age and young adults that were de-churched and unchurched on Milwaukee's East Side. The church grew to several hundred people, and God laid it on Danny's heart to open another location. The old Paradise Theatre in West Allis was identified as the next campus and in 2012 the West Allis Campus opened and rapidly grew to a large, more diversified congregation.

Epikos then planted another campus on the north side of Milwaukee to continue in it's pursuit as a multi-ethnic church in 2016. Then in 2020 Epikos located a permanent home for the north side location and renamed it the Sherman Park Campus. In early 2021, the Mayfair Road Campus was launched in the Wauwatosa neighborhood.

Lastly, we have a food pantry that weekly serves over 100 families from the surrounding areas (located at our Mayfair Road Campus).

# THEOLOGY

## PUBLISHED THEOLOGICAL STATEMENT
