Community Overview

Hilton Head Island is a smaller community with a great mix of locals, part-timers, and vacationers. There are 5,000 students under the age of 18 in our community. Over 50 percent of kids are on the free or reduced lunch program in our schools, and, in contrast, some of the wealthiest people in the country are residents of Hilton Head Island as well. Our demographics of church members reflect our community make-up. Many people who are now full-time residents attended our church as a vacationer at one time in their life. We have many people who have done amazing things in their lives who now live here and are very involved in our church and in nonprofit work. Beaufort County hosts the largest number of nonprofits per capita in the country.

There is one public high school, one public middle school, two public elementary schools, one K-4 school, and one K5 school. We have 4 private schools, two of which are K-12. One private school has recently moved across the bridge to nearby Bluffton, but many people from the Island still attend there. We have several homeschool communities and several hybrid schools for athletes who need a flexible schedule. Many kids come here to train as golfers and tennis players from all over the world.

Why People Like Living Here

HHI boasts a great lifestyle for a family. It's a slower lifestyle with amazing local restaurants. A lot of southern culture is mixed in with a northern influence. There are great sports and arts for kids, and an excellent recreation center for people with great programs. Housing is more expensive than average, but everything else is average to lower. There are a lot of free activities to do in the community, festivals, and the food is great!

Church History

Hilton Head Island Community Church was started in September 2007 as a regional campus of LowCountry Community Church located in Bluffton, SC. Pastor Todd Cullen and his wife Cynthia moved from New York City to plant this campus for LCC. In September 2011, we were "birthed" by LCC with their blessing and financial assistance to become our own independent congregation - Hilton Head Island Community Church. In February 2012, we signed a contract to purchase a permanent facility on the Island within the Hargray Complex on Highway 278. This facility has 13,000 square feet of space on approximately three acres. We had our first services in July 2012.

In the last 6 years, HHICC has completely renovated our main building for adults, kids, and student programming space. We have also added a lawn, a playground, and a patio for our students outside of Backstage. In 2018, we launched ALL IN...a two-year generosity initiative. Our primary goal is to see every person who calls HHICC their church home embrace a generous lifestyle and learn the importance of being a good steward of the financial resources they have been blessed with in their life. Our numeric goal was to receive a total of 3.5 Million by June 2020. We received 3.6M even in the midst of Covid. This allowed us to continue to meet our weekly budget need, pay off our current facility, continue church planting efforts in Belize and NYC, and to purchase and renovate our recently-opened Community Center located directly in front of our Main Building.

Our mission is to passionately share the Message of Jesus Christ and lead people to follow Him. So how do we fulfill our mission? We have identified seven words that define the what and how of our mission.

- Welcoming A church where all people can passionately worship God.
- Loving A church where all people can come without fear of judgment.
- Growing A church that provides safe communities for people to connect with others and grow in their relationship with God.
- Entrusting A church that is intentional in reaching the next generation with the Message of Jesus Christ.
- Serving A church that is "the first call" in our local community serving in whatever way is needed.
- Giving A church that is debt-free so that we can give generously to local and global missions.
- Sending A church with a global presence advancing the Message of Jesus Christ.

We are a modern, worship-focused, and casual corporate gathering. We serve coffee, tea, and snacks every Sunday. Our services are about 65-70 minutes. People say that our services are positive, encouraging, challenging, Biblical, and worshipful. We include the lyrics for every song on the screens and every verse that our pastor uses to help connect people to the Bible.

Tell Us About Your Facility

We have about 26,000 square feet of space over 3 buildings on our campus. This Campus has been renovated to create the space we need for adults, kids, and students. Our Kids space was renovated in 2015 with airbrush artists we hired from Disney. We use the ORANGE curriculum in all our kids' environments so our facility space complements that approach. We recently did a video upgrade to our worship center in June 2020 with four new cameras - three attached in the ceiling and one mobile. We upgraded to Pro7, added a live stream director position, & replaced projectors & added an LED banner for lyrics.

Our main room will seat 320. We have a Backstage Patio venue that has a live feed to an 85 inch TV outside. This venue seats 40 to 50 people. We also have an overflow in our backstage that can seat another 30-40. This is where we have an interactive prayer room following most services as well.

Governance & Polity

HHICC is staff-led and elder-protected. This means that the HHICC staff make the day to-day decisions for the church under the leadership of our Lead Pastor. The elders provide oversight concerning financial matters, staffing, spiritual unity, accountability for the Lead Pastor, and prayer for the staff and church. A stewardship team works as an extension of the elder board that gives a "second-look" to all financial matters and accounting as well as assists with benevolence, facility, and fundraising. It is the role of the staff to raise up and equip volunteers, leaders, and teams to do the work of the ministry in our church and in our community.

The Bible

God has revealed his plan for man in the Bible. We believe that it can clearly be seen in the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:37-40) and Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) that we have a five-fold purpose in life to reach out to the lost and hurting, connect with a local church and small group, grow in our knowledge of and relationship with God, serve others and authentically worship Him through our actions, bringing Him honor and praise in our lives.

If you prefer to not be baptized at the beach, we do offer other baptism opportunities in pools on the Island. We require believer's baptism for membership at HHICC.

Reporting Relationship

The Connections Pastor will report to the Ministry Operations Director but will work with the Executive Team.

Goals and Expectations

Our desire is for every person that calls HHICC their church home to get connected into the life of HHICC the other 6 days by being in a group and through serving with their gifts within the church and in the community. We see this pastor as THE KEY to adults 18 & older moving beyond the Sunday experience into group life and serving throughout the week. Our desire is to have a group for every person who desires to be in a group.

We value the role of coaches who come alongside the Connections Pastor to encourage and equip our group leaders on the journey. We also view the Connections Pastor as someone who is willing to teach the Bible in a master class environment as needed. We have many attenders and members who are new in their faith and understanding of the Bible. Where groups are so important for Christ-followers to grow in their faith in community with others, there is a role for teaching the Bible as well to those who are new to the Bible and understanding it. The Connections Pastor will work with the Lead Pastor on the First time attender process to fully-committed member and will work with our Executive Team to develop this further at HHICC. The Connections Pastor will be responsible to execute the strategy.

Do you have a job description for this role?

- Oversee all Adult Pastoral Care, Adult Groups, Adult Discipleship & Stephen Ministry.
- Work with Women's Group Leader (and future Mens, Couples, etc. coaches) in choosing curriculum, leader development and connection with leaders.
- Provides administrative assistance during the workweek to connect with new attenders, follow up with members, and update the database with new or revised information.
- Provide physical assistance to all staff in Sunday morning set-up, management, clean-up and take-down of Connection Team areas, including managing the offering.
- Oversee lock-up of campus on Sundays including air, trash removal, and setting alarms.
- Provide Pastoral Leadership and Connection on Sundays before and after services.
- Provide online hosts and prayer volunteers for Sunday services.
- Work with the Executive Team on the First Time Attender to Fully Committed Member process at HHICC and execute the strategy.
- Follow up with First Time Attenders and provide the staff with weekly information on new attenders.
